The Pecha Kucha Evening (Friday, February 25, 2011), accordingly titled "**Teach English in the Classroom of the Future**" is certain to spice up and add flavor to this Conference, especially since the host of the evening is renowned teacher trainer, Philip Kerr.

Drawing its name from the Japanese term for the sound of "chit chat", it rests on a presentation format that is based on a simple idea: each speaker is allowed only 6 minutes and 40 seconds to discuss their slideshow of 20 images, each shown for exactly 20 seconds.

Provided with a backdrop of a relaxing atmosphere, it's a format that makes presentations concise, keeping things moving at a rapid pace, thus avoiding the unwanted "death by PowerPoint" situation.
